## Jordyn's Autumn Waltz Quilt Pattern by

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## Finished size 64" x 72"

Read all instructions before starting. All seams are 1/4".

1. You'll be making 120 Half Square Triangle. Did you just feel a little weak in the knees? You can do it! We'll make two at a time using the method described below. Each color will be made with a Cream Wishes background and an Aged Muslin background. Each set will require twelve blocks. Let's get to it!
2. From the Light Background Fabrics cut;

Thirty 7" squares of Cream Wishes, (cut 5 strips 7" x WOF, sub-cut into 7" squares) Thirty 7" squares of Aged Muslin, (cut 5 strips 7"x WOF, sub-cut into 7" squares)

## 2. From the Color Fabrics cut;

Twelve 7" squares of Red Volume, (cut 2 strips 7" x WOF, sub-cut into 7" squares) Twelve 7" squares of Purple Volume, (cut 2 strips 7" x WOF, sub-cut into 7" squares) Twelve 7" squares of Ginger Mandela, (cut 2 strips 7"x WOF, sub-cut into 7" squares) Twelve 7" squares of Brown Music, (cut 2 strips 7" x WOF, sub-cut into 7" squares) Twelve 7" squares of Blue Wishes, (cut 2 strips 7"x WOF, sub-cut into 7" squares)

Split the deck. Pair six squares of one Color Fabric with Cream Wishes and six squares with Aged Muslin. Repeat for all the Color squares; split six squares with one background and six with the other.

## Half Square Triangle Block

1. To create the Half Square Triangles (HSTs), draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of a 7" Light Background square.
2. Pair with a $7 "$ color square and with right sides together, sew a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of the drawn line.
3. Cut on the drawn line to create two HSTs. Press the seam toward the darker fabric. Repeat six times to make a total of twelve HSTs in each of the color ways shown to the right.

Press and then TRIM your Half Square Triangles by lining up the seam with the $45^{\circ}$ line of your ruler. Trim to $61 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square.

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## Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Arrange the blocks like the diagram. Align, pin, and sew the blocks together in the first column. Press the seams as indicated by the arrow. Column should measure $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 72 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat for the other columns alternating the direction the seams are pressed in each column. Nest seams, pin, and sew the columns together. Press. Quilt top should measure $601 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 721 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## Border

Cutting Instructions:
Cut eight $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF of Rust Mandela for Outer Border

1. Trim selvages from the strips. Sew two Rust Mandela strips at the short ends and trim to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 721 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ with the seam at the center. Make two.
2. Sew two Rust Mandela strips at the short ends and trim to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ with the seam at the center. Make two.
3. Align, pin, and sew the Rust Mandela $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 72 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Press seams toward the Outer Border.
4. Align, pin, and sew the Rust Mandela $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press seams toward the Outer Border.
5. Sandwich your quilt top with batting and Ginger Mandela as your backing. Quilt as desired. Bind with Brown Diamonds.
