

Read ALL instructions before beginning. HSTs are 6"Finished Size.
All seams are sewn with a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with fabric right sides together.

## Cutting Instructions

## From the Light fabric cut:

Sixteen 7" squares for Half Square Triangles or use AccuQuilt die \#55001
Four $61 / 2 "$ Light squares for corners
From the Medium fabric cut:
Eight 7" squares for Half Square Triangles or use AccuQuilt die \#55001
Two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips for border


Wyoming Valley Star Block

Two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips for border

## From the Dark fabric cut:

Eight 7" squares for Half Square Triangles or AccuQuilt die \#55001 Four $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for binding

## Half Square Triangles (HSTs)

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the White 7" squares. Pair with eight Medium squares and eight Dark squares.
2. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on both sides of the drawn line.

3. Cut on the drawn line. Press the seam as indicated by the arrow. Trim to $61 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime \prime}$ by aligning the diagonal line of your square with the diagonal seam. It is important to keep the diagonal seam at the corners. Make a total of sixteen Medium and Light HSTs and sixteen Dark and Light HSTs. Trim dog ears.
4. Lay out three Medium HSTs and one Light $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square like the diagram for the Corner Units.
5. Sew the top two squares together. Sew the bottom two squares together. Press the seams as the arrows indicate.
6. Nest seams, pin, and sew the top row to the bottom row. Press the seam as the arrow indicates. The unit should measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make four.
7. Lay out four Medium HSTs like the diagram for the Center Unit. Repressing the seams of two of the HSTs toward the light may be helpful in nesting your seams.



TRIM to $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Make sixteen HSTs of each color set.

9. Make one.
8. Sew the top two squares together. Sew the bottom two squares together. Press the seams as the arrows indicate.
9. Nest seams, pin, and sew the top row to the bottom row. Press the seam as the arrow indicates. The unit should measure $12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.
10. Lay out four Dark HSTs like the diagram for the side Chevron Units.
11. Sew the top two squares together. Sew the

12. Make four. bottom two squares together. Press the seams as the arrows indicate.
12. Nest seams, pin, and sew the top row to the bottom row. Press the seam as the arrow indicates. The unit should measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make four.
13. Arrange the HSTs units like the diagram.
14. Align, pin, and sew the horizontal rows together. Press seams as the arrows indicate.

15. Align, pin, and sew the rows together. Press the seams as indicated. The quilt top should measure $361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
16. Align, pin, and sew the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Outer Border strips to the left and rights sides. Press seams as the arrows indicate.
17. Align, pin, and sew the $3^{112 \prime 2} \times 42^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$ Outer Border strips to the top and bottom. Press seams as the arrows indicate.

Quilt as desired, label, and bind. Great job!

The clear and detailed cutting and sewing diagrams make the block assembly quick and easy!

## Fabric Requirements

1 YD of Dark fabric, includes $3 / 8$ yard for the binding
1 YD of Medium fabric
1 YD of Light fabric
Backing: 3 Yds of 42" wide fabric
Or $11 / 2$ Yds of 108 " wide fabric for a no-seam back
Batting: 48" x 48" minimum size
