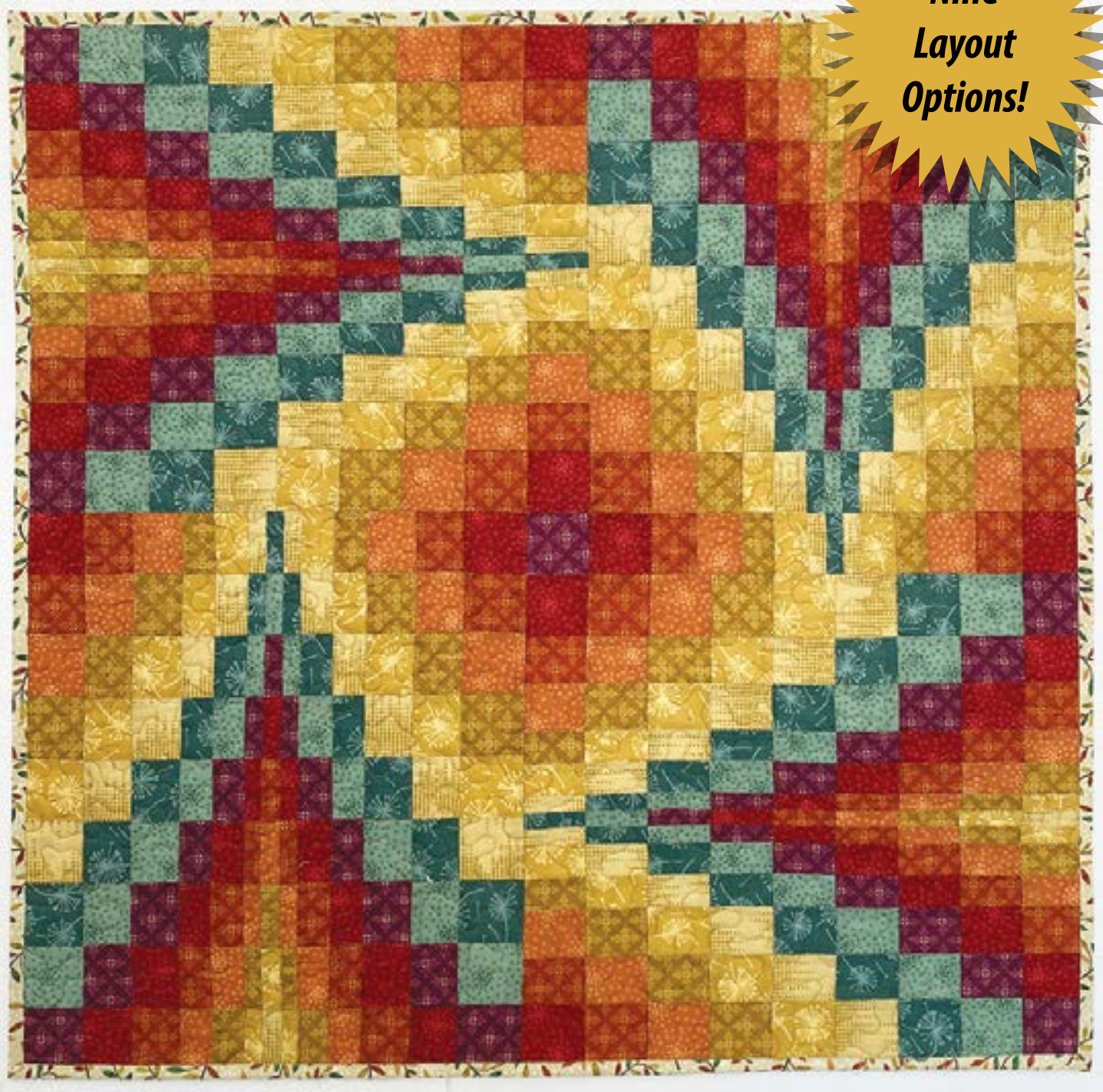

# Scarecrow's Bargello Table Topper

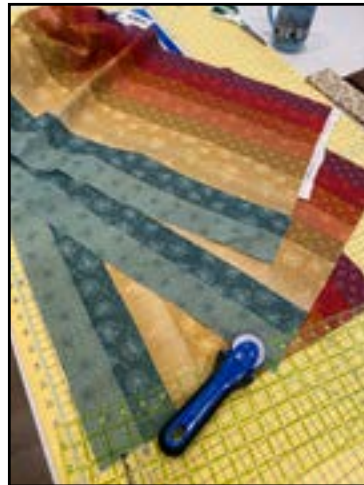
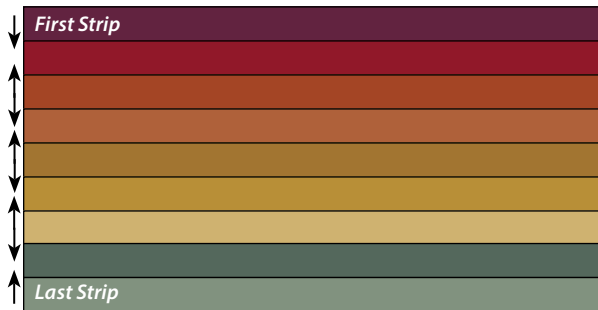
The required yardage for the **Scarecrow's Song Panel pattern** left some extra yardage. So let's make a coordinating **Bargello Table Topper** to match the **Scarecrow's Song Panel quilt!** If you didn't make the **Scarecrow's Fly Away Song Panel quilt**, you'll need the yardage on the right.

## Cutting Instructions

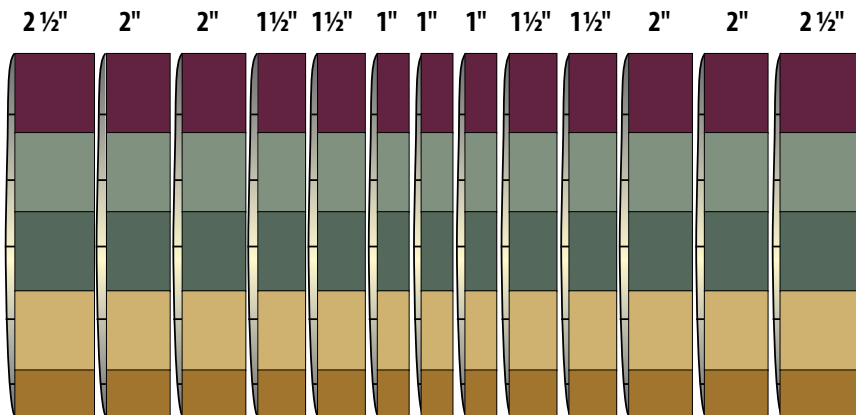
Three 2 1/2" x 35" from each of the nine fabrics on the right (*longer is fine*)  
 One 2 1/2" square of Purple (*the other layouts don't require this square*)

## Sewing Instructions

- Align and sew the strips together in the following order. Make three sets. The strip set should measure 35" x 18 1/2". Adjust your seam allowance and repress if necessary. Press the seams in alternating directions. *Don't worry if the ends are slightly uneven.*



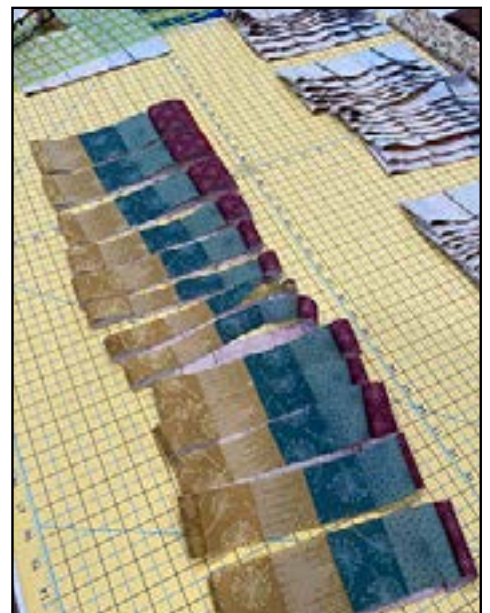
- Align the **First Strip** with the **Last Strip**, right sides together. Pin and sew a 1/4" seam along the long side, making a tube. Make three strip tubes. Don't press this last seam.
- Lay the tube on a cutting mat while it is still wrong side out. Align the tube with the lines of the mat making it as straight as you can. Trim the selvage/uneven edge to straighten the end. Cut the tube into the following widths.



Set these strips aside as one **Bargello Block Unit**. Continue to cut the same set of measurements from the remainder of the first tube and from the second tube. Cut four **Bargello Block** sets from the three strip tubes. *It is important to keep the Bargello Block pieces in order and together!*

If you didn't have left over yardage from the **Scarecrow's Song Fly Away Panel quilt** pattern, you'll need:

-  1/4 yard
-  1/4 yard
-  1/4 yard
-  1/4 yard
-  1/4 yard
-  1/4 yard
-  1/4 yard
-  1/4 yard
-  1/4 yard
-  1/2 yard binding  
1 1/4 yard backing



- Cut four **Bargello Block** pieces from the three strip tubes.

4. Turn the strips right side out and lay out your strip set as shown in diagram 3 on the previous page.

a. From the first 2 1/2" width tube, with a seam ripper, pick out the seam between the Purple and Red squares.

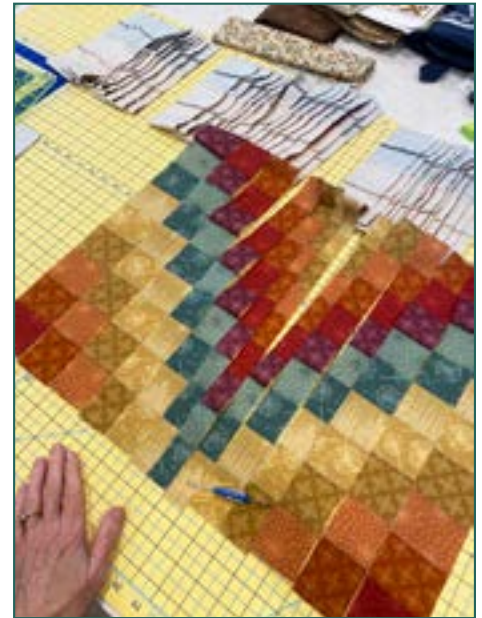
b. From the second 2" width tube, pick out the seam between the Red and the Dark Orange squares.

c. From the third 2" width tube, pick out the seam between the Dark Orange and the Light Orange squares.

d. From the fourth 1 1/2" width tube, pick out the seam between the Light Orange and the Dark Gold squares.

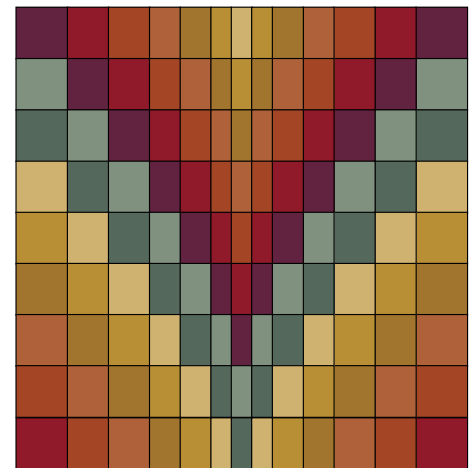


Strips should look like a V

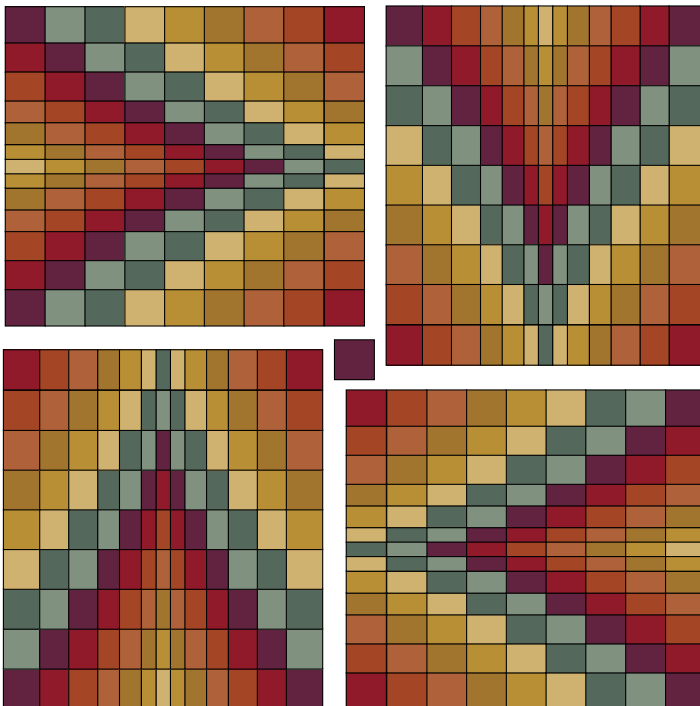
e. Continue in the same manner for the first 7 strips. Reverse the seam ripping order for the last 6 strips. Your strip set should look like a V.

5. Nest seams, pin, and sew the strips together. Press the seams in one direction. The block should measure 16 1/2" x 18 1/2". Repeat to make a total of four identical **Bargello** blocks.

6. Arrange the four **Bargello** blocks and the 2 1/2" Purple square like diagram 6. Check out the other layout options on page 4.



5. Make four identical **Bargello** blocks

7. Align the Purple 2 ½" square with the lower right corner of the upper left **Bargello** block. Sew a partial ¼" seam, about 1 ½", leaving at least an inch unsewn.

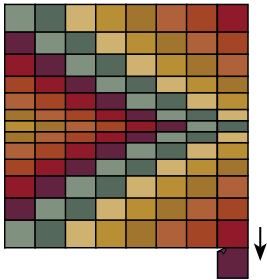
8. Press the partial seam toward the purple square.

9. Align, pin, and sew the upper right **Bargello** block to the left side of the upper left Bargello block. Press the seam as the arrow indicates.

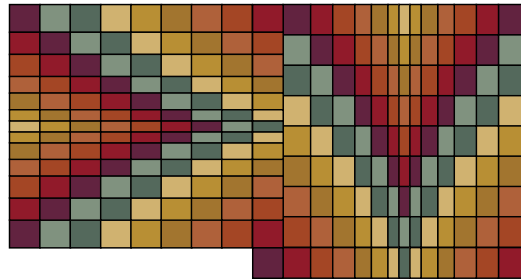
10. Align, pin, and sew the lower right **Bargello** block to the bottom of the upper right Bargello block. Press the seam as the arrow indicates.



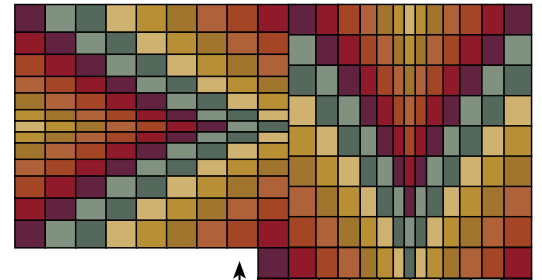

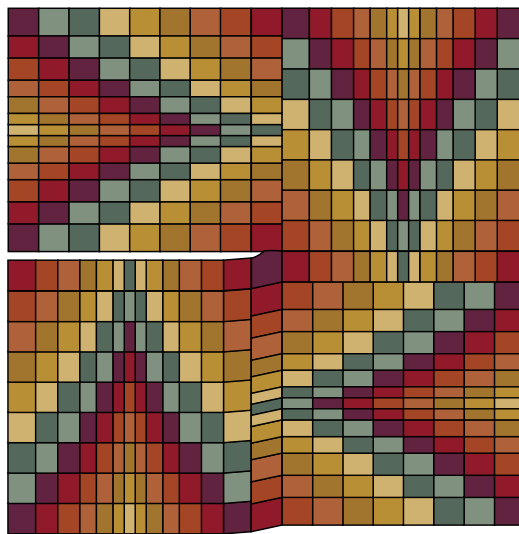

11. Align, pin, and sew the lower left **Bargello** block to the left side of the lower right **Bargello** block. Press the seam as the arrow indicates.

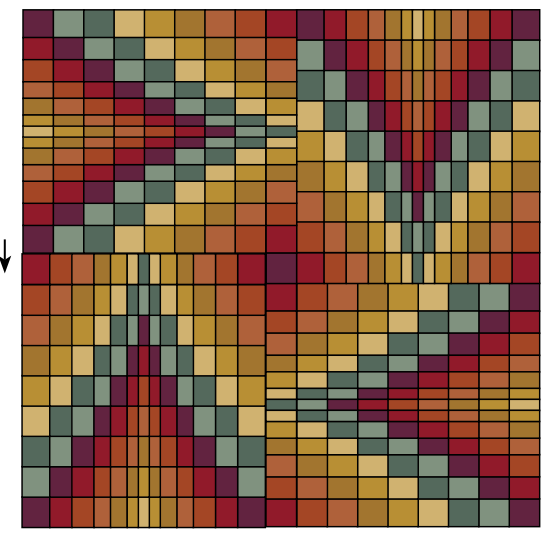
12. Align, pin, and sew the partial seam, lower left **Bargello** block to the upper left **Bargello** block. Press the seam as the arrow indicates.

13. Quilt as desired, label, and bind. *Great job!*
