Cutting Instructions

R590985P Trim Scarecrow's Song Panel to measure 22 1/2" x 42 1/2".



R590989D-Cream

Cut one strip 6 1/2" x WOF, sub-cut into
One 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle
One 6 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangle
Three 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles
Three 6 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

Cut four strips 3" x WOF, sub-cut into
Forty-four 3" squares for **Flying Geese**

Cut three strips 2 1/2" x WOF, sub-cut into
Three 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles for **Birdhouses**
Eighteen 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
Fourteen 2 1/2" x 1" rectangles for **Birdhouses**

Cut two strips 2 1/4" x WOF, sub-cut into
Six 2 1/4" x 6 1/2" rectangles for **Birdhouses**
Eight 2 1/4" x 2 1/2" rectangles for **Birdhouses**

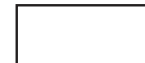

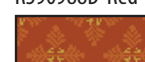

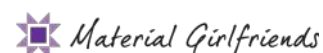

R590569D-Teal

One 5 1/2" square for **Flying Geese**
Six 3 1/2" x WOF for **Outer Border**



R590570D-Brown

One 5 1/2" square for **Flying Geese**
Three 1" x 6 1/2" for **Birdhouses**
Four 1" x 2 1/2" for **Birdhouses**
Seven 1 1/4" appliqué circles for **Birdhouses**
The remaining fabric is for binding

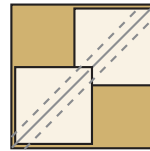
Flying Geese Units

1. To make the **Flying Geese**, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Cream 3" squares.

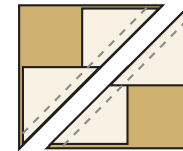

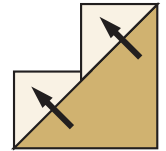
2. Right sides together, position the two Cream squares in opposite corners of the 5 1/2" color square like the diagram. Position the Cream squares so there are about 1/16" (just a few threads) of the color square showing underneath the Cream squares. Pin in place, and sew a 1/4" seam on each side of the drawn line.



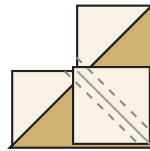

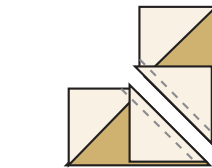

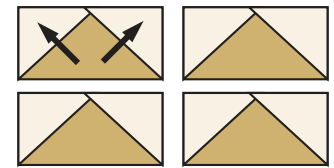
3. Cut on the drawn line. Press the seam as indicated by the arrows on both units.

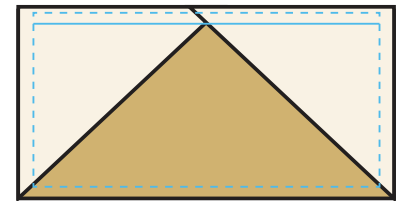

4. Position another Cream 3" square so there is about 1/16" (just a few threads) of the color square showing underneath the Cream square. Pin and sew 1/4" seam on each side of the drawn line. Repeat for the other unit.

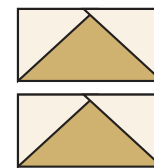
5. Cut on the drawn line. Press seams as the arrows indicate. *Presto*, four **Flying Geese**.

6. **Trim to 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"**. Align 1/4" at the point of the V (solid blue line) and trim to 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" (dotted blue line). The diagonal of the wings should meet at the bottom left and right corners.

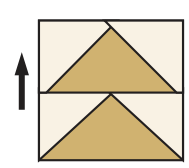


6. Trim to 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

7. Align two **Flying Geese** like the diagram. Pin, sew, and press the seam as the arrow indicates. The **Flying Geese** unit should measure 4 1/2" square.



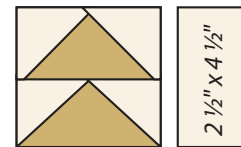

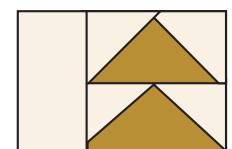
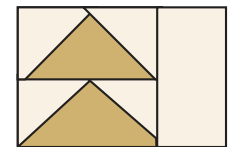

8. Repeat steps 1 through 7 to create two **Flying Geese** units in each of the eight fabrics, but only one set for the Medium Teal, and one set for the Sage. *Set aside four Brown, two Medium Teal, and two Sage Flying Geese for the Birdhouse roofs.*

9. Refer to the quilt image on page 5 for left/right rectangle placement. Align a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle to the right (or left) side of the **Flying Geese** unit. Align, pin, and sew. Press the seam toward the rectangle. Unit should measure 6 1/2" x 4 1/2".

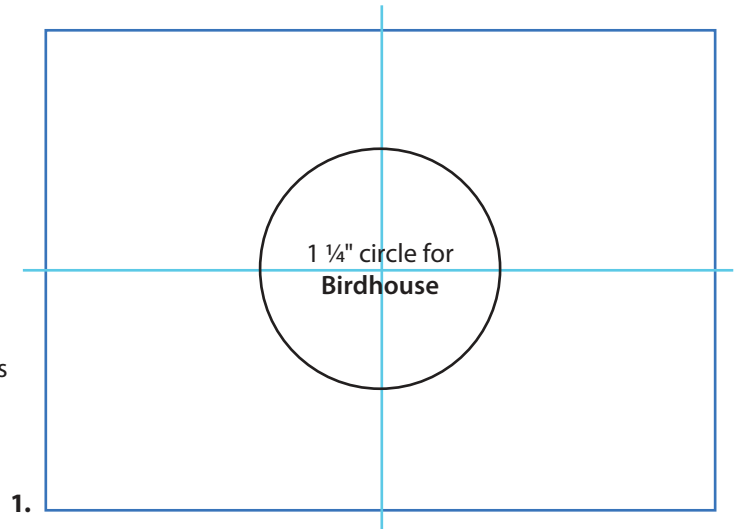
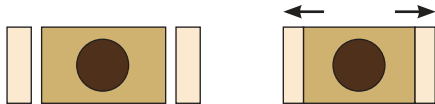

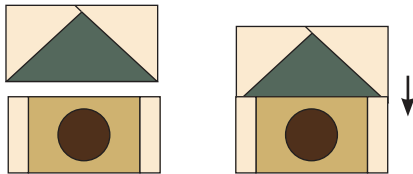

Birdhouse Blocks

- Using your preferred appliqué method, appliqué the Brown circle to the center of the Light Gold $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ house rectangle. Fusible appliqué was used for the sample quilt. Visit YouTube, Material Girlfriends Patterns channel for Fusible Appliqué tutorials. If a hand appliqué method is used, add seam allowance as needed.
- Align, pin, and sew a Cream $1'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle to the left and right sides of the **Birdhouse** unit. Press the seams as the arrows indicate. The unit should measure $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$.



- Align, pin, and sew a Medium Teal **Flying Geese** to the top of the **Birdhouse** unit. Press the seam as the arrow indicates. The **Birdhouse** block should measure $4\frac{1}{2}''$ square. *Too cute!*



- Repeat to make seven **Birdhouse** blocks in the following colorways.

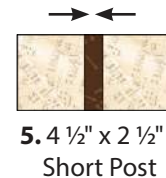

- Arrange two Cream $2\frac{1}{4}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles and one Brown $1'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle like the diagram. Align, pin, and sew the Cream rectangles to the Brown rectangle. Press seams toward the Brown rectangle. Repeat to make four **Birdhouse** Short Post units.



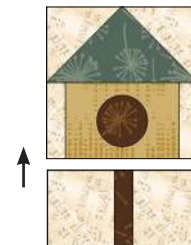
5. $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$
Short Post

- Arrange two Cream $2\frac{1}{4}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles and one Brown $1'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle like the diagram. Align, pin, and sew the Cream rectangles to the Brown rectangle. Press the seams toward the Brown rectangle. Repeat to make three **Birdhouse** Tall Post units.



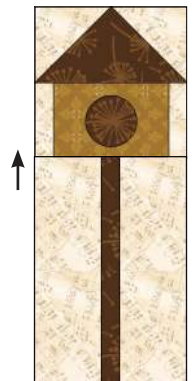
6. $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$
Tall Post

- Align, pin, and sew the **Birdhouse** Short Post units to the bottom of the first four **Birdhouse** blocks shown in step 4. Press the seam toward the **Birdhouse** unit. The block should measure $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$.



7. $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$

- Align, pin, and sew the **Birdhouse** Tall Post units to the last three **Birdhouse** blocks shown in step 4. Press the seam toward the **Birdhouse** unit. The block should measure $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$.

Quilt Top Assembly

Refer to the diagram on page 5.

1. Center and trim **Scarecrow's Song Panel** to measure 22 ½" x 42 ½".
2. Arrange the **Flying Geese** units and a Cream 6 ½" x 2 ½" rectangle for the left side of the panel, shown as **2.** on page 5.
 - a. Align, pin, and sew the **Flying Geese** units and rectangle together. Press seams as the arrow indicates.
 - b. Align, pin, and sew the **Flying Geese** border to the left side of the panel. Ease any differences. Press the seam toward the panel.
3. Arrange the **Birdhouse Tall Post** units and a Cream 6 ½" x 12 ½" rectangle for the right side of the panel, shown as **3.** on page 5.
 - a. Align, pin, and sew the Cream 2 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles to the left or right side of the **Birdhouse Tall Post** blocks. Press the seam toward the Cream rectangle.
 - b. Align, pin, and sew the **Birdhouse Tall Post** blocks and the Cream 6 ½" x 12 ½" rectangle together. Press the seams as the arrow indicates.
 - c. Align, pin, and sew the **Birdhouse Tall Post** border to the right side of the panel. Ease any differences. Press the seam toward the panel.
4. Arrange the **Flying Geese** units and a Cream 6 ½" x 2 ½" rectangle for the top of the panel, shown as **4.** on page 5.
 - a. Align, pin, and sew the left **Flying Geese** unit and rectangle together. Press the seam toward the Cream rectangle.
 - b. Align, pin, and sew the **Flying Geese** units together. Press the seams as the arrow indicates.
 - b. Align, pin, and sew the **Flying Geese** border to the top of the panel. Ease any differences. Press the seam toward the panel.
5. Arrange the **Birdhouse Short Post** units, one Cream 6 ½" x 7 ½" rectangle, three 6 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles, and one 6 ½" x 2 ½" rectangle for the bottom of the panel, shown as **5.** on page 5.
 - a. Align, pin, and sew the Cream rectangles and the **Birdhouse Short Post** blocks together. Press the seams as the arrow indicates.
 - b. Align, pin, and sew the **Birdhouse Short Post** border to the bottom of the panel. Ease any differences. Press the seam toward the panel.
 - c. Press the quilt top well. It should measure 34 ½" x 54 ½".
6. **Inner Border Strips**
 - a. Trim selvages, then trim two of the 1 ½" strips for the **Inner Border** to 34 ½". Align, pin, and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press the seam toward the inner border.
 - b. Trim selvages and sew two strips end to end. Make two sets.
 - c. With the seam in the center, trim the strips to 56 ½". Align, pin, and sew **Inner Border** strips to the left and right sides of the quilt top. The quilt top should measure 36 ½" x 56 ½".
7. **Middle Border Strips**
 - a. Trim selvages, then trim two of the 2 ½" strips for the **Middle Border** to 36 ½". Align, pin, and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press seam toward the middle border.
 - b. Trim selvages and sew two strips end to end. Make two sets.
 - c. With the seam in the center, trim the strips to 60 ½". Align, pin, and sew **Middle Border** strips to the left and right sides of the quilt top. The quilt top should measure 40 ½" x 60 ½".
8. **Outer Border Strips**
 - a. Trim selvages, then trim two of the 3 ½" strips for the **Outer Border** to 40 ½". Align, pin, and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press seam toward the middle border.
 - b. Trim selvages and sew two strips end to end. Make two sets.
 - c. With the seam in the center, trim the strips to 66 ½". Align, pin, and sew **Outer Border** strips to the left and right sides of the quilt top. The quilt top should measure 46 ½" x 66 ½".
9. Quilt, bind, label, and enjoy! *Great job!*
