3YD Bravo Digital Quilt Pattern 42" x 52"





3YD Bravo

Read through the entire pattern before starting. Fabric is sewn right sides together with 1/4" seam. WOF mean Width of Fabric.

Cutting Instructions

Dark Fabric Cut:

One 5 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut into six 5 ½" squares for Chain Block centers Three 3 %" x WOF strips, sub-cut into twenty-four 3 %" squares for Flying Geese wings Two 3" x 42 1/2" strips for left and right Middle Borders

Two 3" x 37 ½" strips for the top and bottom Middle Borders

Medium Fabric Cut:

One 5 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut into six 5 ½" squares for the center of the Sawtooth Block

Two 2 ¾" x 42" for top and bottom Outer Border

Four 2 ¾" x WOF strips; sew two strips end-to-end and trim to 2 ¾" x 47 ½" for left and right Outer Border

Two 1 34" x WOF strips for 4-Patch unit for the Chain Block

Two 1 ½" x 32 ½" strips for top and bottom Inner Border

Two 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips for left and right Inner Border

Light Fabric Cut:

One 6 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut into six 6 ½" square for Flying Geese body Two 5 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut into twenty-four 5 ½" x 3" rectangles for Chain Block Two 3" x WOF strips, sub-cut into twenty 3" squares for Flying Geese Block corners Two 1 3/4" x WOF strips for 4-Patch unit for the Chain Block

Sawtooth Block Construction

- 1. To make the **Flying Geese**, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Dark 3 %" squares.
- 2. Right sides together, position two of the Dark squares in opposite corners of the 6 1/2" Light square like the diagram. Pin in place, and sew a ¼" seam on each side of the drawn line.
- 3. Cut on the drawn line. Press the seam as indicated by the arrows on both units.
- 4. Position another Dark 3 ½" square as indicated. Pin and sew 1/4" seam on each side of the drawn line. Repeat for the other unit.




























- 5. Cut on the drawn line. Press seams as the arrows indicate. Presto, four Flying Geese.
- 6. Trim to 3" x 5 1/2". Align 1/4" at the point of the V (solid blue line) and trim to 3" x 5 ½" (dotted blue line). The diagonal of the wings should meet in the bottom left and right corners.
- 7. Repeat steps 1 through 6 to create six sets of Flying Geese with Dark wings and Light body.




6. Trim to 3" x 5 ½"

- 8. Arrange the **Sawtooth** block units as in diagram 8.
- Pin and sew the top row units together. Pin and sew the middle row. Pin and sew the bottom row. Press seams as directed by the arrows.
- 10. Nest seams, pin, and sew the top and middle rows together. Nest seams, pin, and sew the bottom row to the middle row. Press as









arrows indicate. Sawtooth block should measure 10 1/2" square. Make six.


Chain Block Construction


- 1. Align and sew a Medium 1 ¾" x WOF strip and a Light 1 ¾" x WOF strip together. Make two strip sets. Press seam toward the Medium fabric. Sub-cut strip sets into forty-eight 1 ¾" x 3" rectangles.
- 2. Position two of the 1 3/4" x 3" rectangle units like the diagram. Right sides together, nest seam and sew, creating a 4-patch. Press seam in either direction or do a 4-patch Clockwise Spin Press (see the Material Girlfriends Patterns Video channel on Youtube). Make twenty-four 4-Patch units.



- 3. Arrange the **Chain** block units as in diagram 3.
- 4. Pin and sew the top row units together. Pin and sew the middle row. Pin and sew the bottom row. Press seams as directed by the arrows.
- 5. Nest seams, pin, and sew the top and middle rows together. Nest seams, pin, and sew the bottom row to the middle row. Press as








arrows indicate. Chain block should measure 10 ½" square. Make six.



Quilt Top Construction

- 1. Arrange your blocks like the layout below.
- 2. Align seams, pin, and sew the blocks together in the first row. Press seams to the right. Align seams, pin, and sew the second row together. Press seams to the left. Continue in the same manner until all the rows are sewn.
- 3. Nest seams, pin, and sew the rows together. Press seams in one direction.
- 4. Press very well before adding the borders. Quilt top should measure 30 ½" x 40 ½". Align, pin, and sew the left and right Inner Border strips to the quilt top. Press seams toward the darker fabric. Align, pin, and sew the top and bottom Inner Borders to the quilt top. Press seams toward the darker fabric. Quilt top should measure 32 ½" x 42 ½".
- 5. Align, pin, and sew the left and right Middle Border strips to the quilt top. Press seams toward the darker fabric. Align, pin, and sew the top and bottom Middle Border strips to the quilt top. Press seams toward the darker fabric. Quilt top should measure 37 ½" x 47 ½".
- Align, pin, and sew the left and right Outer Border strips to the quilt top. Press seams toward the darker fabric. Align, pin, and sew the top and bottom Outer Border strips to the quilt top. Press seams toward the darker fabric. Quilt top should measure 42 ½" x 52 ½".

Quilt, bind, and enjoy!

Batting: 48" x 60" minimum size

Binding: ½ yard
