Interwoven Hearts Quilt Pattern

Interwoven Hearts is a beautiful, quick, and easy project that works perfectly as a table topper, wall hanging, or baby quilt. The charming heart design makes it ideal for February décor, yet versatile enough to enjoy all year long.

Read all instructions before beginning. All seams are $\frac{1}{4}$ ", right sides together. WOF = Width of Fabric

Cutting Instructions

From the Light fabric, cut

Two strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF; sub-cut into four $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for **Sashing**

One strip $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF; sub-cut into four $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for corner of **Heart** blocks

One strip $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF; sub-cut into sixteen $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for **Half Snowball** units

From each of the four heart fabrics (two Medium, two Dark), cut

One strip $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF; sub-cut into two $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for **Half Snowball** units

One strip $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF; sub-cut into three $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9" rectangles for **Nine Patch** units

From the Border fabric, cut

Two strips $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF; sub-cut into two $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $22\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and two $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $30\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

Fussy-cut one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square from the border fabric for the Center Square

From the Flange/Binding fabric, cut





Four strips 1" x WOF, sub-cut into 1" x $22\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for **Flange**

Four $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF for Binding (or your preferred width)

Piecing Instructions for the Hearts

Half Snowball Unit

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Light** squares.
2. Right sides together, place a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Light** square in the upper left corner of a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Refer to the diagram for placement. Sew on the drawn line.
3. Place a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Light** square in the upper right corner and sew on the drawn line.
4. Trim the corner a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the seam.
5. Press the seams as the arrows indicate. Repeat for the rest of the heart to yield two **Half Snowball** units for each **Medium** and **Dark** Heart fabrics. You will have 8 total **Half Snowball** units. The units should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".



5. Make two of each color

Nine Patch Square

6. Arrange **one Medium** and **one Dark** color set of $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9" rectangles like the diagrams.

Align and sew the top rectangle to the middle rectangle, then sew to the bottom rectangle. Press the seams as the arrows indicate. The units should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9".




6. Medium Set A



Dark Set B


7. Cut both **Set A** and **Set B** units into 2 ½" segments.
You'll need three strip units from each **Set A** and **Set B**.




8. Arrange the 2 ½" strip units into a **Nine Patch** square as shown in diagram 8. Nest the seams, pin, and sew the strip units together. Press the seams as indicated by the arrow.

7. Cut **Set A** and **Set B** into three 3 ½" x 6 ½" units.

9. Arrange the remaining 2 ½" strip units into a **Nine Patch** square as shown in diagram 9. Nest the seams, pin and sew the strip units together. Press the seams as the arrow indicates. The **Nine Patch** blocks should measure 6 ½" square.




10. Repeat to create the second set of **Medium** and **Dark Nine Patch** blocks using the other two **Medium** and **Dark** fabrics. **Nine Patch** units should measure 6 ½" square.



Assembling the Heart Block


11. Arrange a 4 ½" **Light** square, a **Dark Nine Patch** square and two coordinating **Half Snowball** units as shown in diagram 11.
12. Sew the 4 ½" **Light** square to the top of the **Half Snowball** unit. Sew the right **Half Snowball** unit to the top of the **Nine Patch** square. Press the seams as indicated by the arrows.




13. Nest the seam, pin, and sew the left side to the right side. Press the seam as the arrow indicates.

14. Repeat to complete the other three **Heart** blocks. **Heart** blocks should measure 10 ½" square.







Assembling the Quilt Top

1. Arrange four **Heart** blocks, four **Light Sashing** rectangles and the **2 1/2" Center Square** as shown.
2. Align, pin, and sew the left three units together. Align, pin, and sew the middle three units together. Align, pin, and sew the right three units together. Press the seams as indicated by the arrows.
3. Sew the left column to the middle column, then sew to the right column. Press the seams as indicated by the arrows. The quilt top should measure 22 1/2" square.



Flange and Border


4. Fold and press the **Flange** strips in half lengthwise so that the right side of the fabric is to the outside and now measures 1/2" x 22 1/2".

Align the raw edges of the **Flange** strip to the raw edges of the quilt top. Pin and sew with a scant 1/4" seam and a large basting stitch along the top and the bottom. Repeat for the left and right sides. Press flat.


5. With a 1/4" seam allowance and a regular stitch length, align, pin, and sew the 4 1/2" x 22 1/2" **Border** strips to the left and right sides. Press the seams as indicated by the arrows. The seams should cover the **Flange** seam so that it doesn't show on the front. Remove any **Flange** basting stitch that might show.

Align, pin, and sew the 30 1/2" **Border** strips to the top and bottom. Press the seams as indicated by the arrows. Remove any **Flange** basting stitch that might show.


Quilt as desired. Bind and label. *Enjoy your beautiful quilt!*

This pattern is beginner-friendly. The clear step-by-step instructions and diagrams make assembly a breeze.

Fabric Requirements

1/3 yard each of two Medium fabrics for the Heart blocks (two pinks)

1/3 yard each of two Dark fabrics for the Hearts blocks (two reds)

1/2 yard of Light fabric (background)

2/3 yard Border fabric

1/2 yard Flange and Binding

1 1/4 yard for Backing

38" x 38" square of batting
