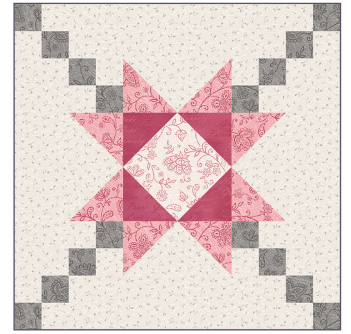







Month 3 - Irish Chain Sawtooth Blocks

Middle Left, Right, Top, and Bottom Stars - 12" Finished Size, 12 1/2" Unfinished Size
WOF means Width of Fabric and **FG** means Flying Geese

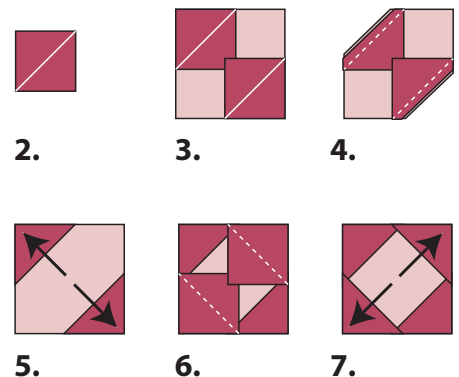
Cutting Instructions for Four Blocks

- 
0531-1042
 Four 5 1/4" squares for **FG**
 Sixteen 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles for sides
 Thirty-two 2 1/2" squares for Irish Chain
 Three 1 1/2" x WOF strips for Irish Chain
-

 Four 4 1/2" squares for Square-in-a-Square Center
-

 Sixteen 2 7/8" squares for **FG**
-

 Sixteen 2 1/2" squares for Square-in-a-Square corners
-

 Three 1 1/2" x **WOF** strips for Irish Chain

- Sew the **Flying Geese** according to the cutting and sewing instructions on page 3. Make sixteen **FG** with the Cream 5 1/4" squares and Pink 2 7/8" squares.

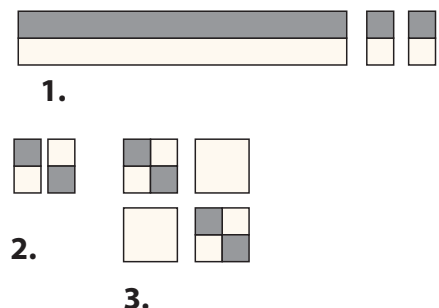
Square-in-a-Square Block

- Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of the Ruby 2 1/2" squares.
- With right sides together, place two squares in opposite corners as shown with the 4 1/2" Light Pink square, pin in place, and sew on the drawn line.
- Trim 1/4" away from the seam toward the outside corners.
- Press seams toward the Ruby.
- With right sides together, place the other two squares in opposite corners as shown. Pin in place and sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" from the seam just as before.
- Press toward the Ruby fabric. Should measure 4 1/2" square.

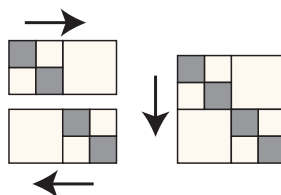


Irish Chain Block

- Sew a Gray and a Cream 1 1/2" strip together along the long sides. Repeat to make two more sets. Press seams toward the Gray strips. Cut strip sets into sixty-four 1 1/2" units.
- Pair units as shown. Nest seam, pin, sew, and press seam to one side. Make 32 **Four-Patch** units.
- Lay out the **Four-Patch** units and the Cream 2 1/2" squares as shown.



- Sew the top two units together. Sew the bottom two together. Press seams in alternating directions.

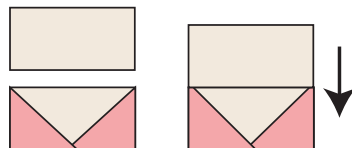

- Align seam, pin, and sew the top to the bottom. Make 16 **Irish Chain** blocks. Should measure 4 1/2" square.

Flying Geese Unit

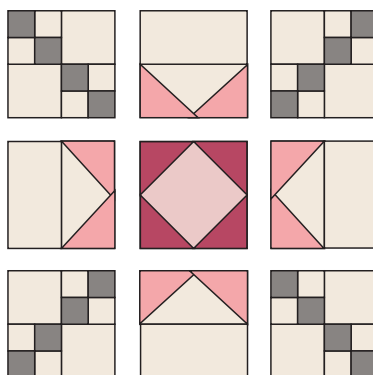
- Sew a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle to the **FG** unit like the diagram to the right. Press the seam toward the **FG**. Should measure 4 1/2" square.



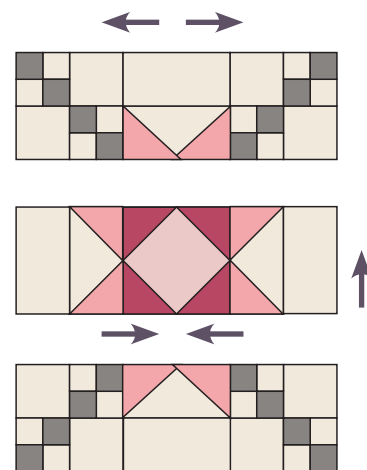

Block Assembly Directions

- Lay out the **Irish Chain**, **Flying Geese** unit, **Square-in-a-Square** blocks, as in diagram 1.
- Sew the pieces into rows. Press the seams in alternating directions.
- Align the seams, pin, and sew the rows together. Repeat to make four **Irish Chain Sawtooth** blocks. Should measure 12 1/2".
