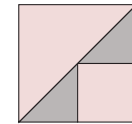


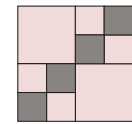
Month 5 Pieced Border Blocks

Corner Square Triangle Blocks and Irish Chain Blocks
 4" Finished Size, 4 1/2" Unfinished Size, **WOF** means Width of Fabric



Corner Square Triangle Blocks

Irish Chain Block

Cutting Instructions

0532-1059



Ten 4 7/8" squares, cut once on the diagonal for 20 triangles
 Thirty-six 2 1/2" squares for Corner Square Triangles (20) and Irish Chain (16)
 Two 1 1/2" x **WOF** strips for Irish Chain

Twenty 2 7/8" squares, cut once on the diagonal for 40 triangles

Two 1 1/2" x **WOF** strips for Irish Chain

Irish Chain Block

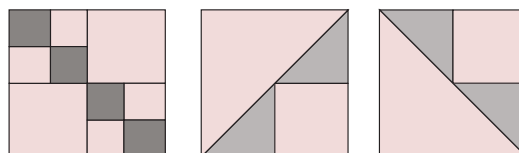
1. Refer to Month 3, page 6 for sewing directions. Make 16 **Four-Patch** units in order to complete 8 **Irish Chain** blocks.

Corner Square Triangle Block

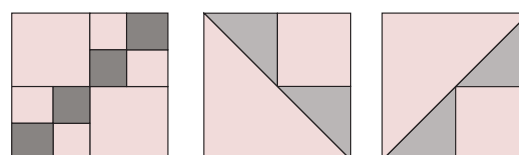
1. A little 'tail' will hang off on this side. Sew and press seam toward the triangle.
2. Align the other triangle along this side of the square. Sew and press toward the triangle.
3. Center the large triangle by finger pressing a center crease. Pin and sew.
4. Press toward the larger triangle and square up to 4 1/2".

5. Make 20 **Corner Square Triangle** blocks. Set aside four blocks for the corners.

6. Arrange the blocks in two layouts, **Set A** and **Set B**.

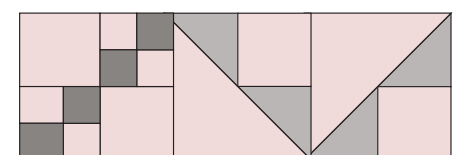
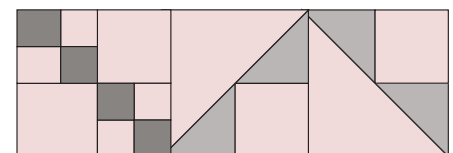


6. Set A

7. Sew the blocks together and press the seams in one direction. Make 4 of each layout. Should measure 12 1/2" x 4 1/2".
